



## Frequently Asked Questions

### **What are CAW park hours?**

Due to Daylight Saving Time changes The Park is now open everyday from 8AM to 6PM.

### **How much is admission to the park?**

Adult Day passes are \$25 and \$15 for children age 17 and younger. An adult two day pass is \$35.00. Kids 3 years old and younger are admitted to the park for free. Individual Annual pass is \$350; Family Annual pass (traditional family of 4 or less – parents and 2 children age 17 or younger) is \$500. Additional family members over 4 are only \$75.00 per member on a Family Annual Pass plan. All ticket prices are subject to sales tax.

### **What are the hours of the Blue Sky Zip Line?**

### **What about rental equipment?**

ATV Rentals are \$140.00 per day - Friday thru Sunday and Holidays (includes park admission).  
ATV Rentals are \$90.00 per day - Monday thru Thursday (includes park admission).  
Golf Cart Rentals are \$20.00 per day. Golf Carts are allowed on Service Roads only.  
Renters must be 18 years or older with a valid drivers license and credit card (American Express, MasterCard, Visa)

### **Why must I sign a waiver?**

You are responsible for your own experience at CAW. Riding trails, motocross courses, cart paths, and Canopy Tour can be dangerous and requires certain skills and competence to avoid serious injury.

### **Are there age restrictions for riding and operating equipment?**

Anyone under the age of 18 must have a parent or legal guardian sign the liability waiver and on-site with them at all times. CAW recommends that you follow Federal Guidelines on ATV age restrictions

**What about alcohol?**

CAW has a no alcohol policy. Don't ask - - - Don't tell

**Can we ride at night?**

CAW is scheduling night rides. Please watch our web site for details.

**Why no aggressive tire patterns?**

Please no Paddle, Blade, Spike, or Chains. All others are welcomed at CAW.  
Please don't rut out the trails or service roads. Use designated mud area.

**What's different about CAW and other parks we've visited?**
